Through the Idaho Summit on Prescription Drug Diversion, law enforcement organizations, medical regulatory bodies and health care organizations have joined together to combat prescription drug abuse and diversion.

During the four-hour summit, we will discuss how prescriptions are diverted to street sales, the community impact, the law enforcement response, and criteria for prosecution of cases. We will provide tools for health care providers and health care organizations to identify diversion and diversion risks. Our objective is not only to slow the flow of diverted prescription drugs but also to open a dialogue and promote understanding between the medical community and law enforcement about each other's practices and concerns.
