MINUTES:

ADMINISTRATION:

The PA Committee reviewed their Financial Status Report. (No Action Required)

The PA Committee reviewed IDAPA 22.01.03, Rules for the Licensure of Physician Assistants and IDAPA 22.01.04, Rules of the Board of Medicine for Registration of Supervising and Directing Physicians regarding supervision of PA trainees. The PA Committee acted to recommend to the Board of Medicine that the PA Trainee application be signed by the PA program director and proctor(s) and list the practice rotations. The PA Committee noted that there is no provision in the Rules requiring PA trainees to have a registered supervising physician.

The PA Committee reviewed the position statement regarding out of state supervising physicians that was presented to the Board of Medicine at its December 2013 meeting. The PA Committee acted to recommend changes to the position statement and will present them to the Board at its June 2014 meeting.
