RESPIRATORY THERAPY LICENSURE BOARD
SPECIAL MEETING VIA CONFERENCE CALL
Boise, Idaho
May 25, 2011

On May 25, 2011, the Respiratory Therapy Licensure Board (RT Board) convened by conference call. Participating were RT Board members Chairman Rich White, RT, Coeur d'Alene; Diana Lincoln-Haye, RPSGT, RT, Kimberly; Paul Durham, public member, Boise and Carrie Massey, RT, Blackfoot. Also attending were Mary Leonard, Associate Director and Cathleen Morgan, Board Counsel. Marilyn Schuller, public member was absent and excused

Chairperson Rich White, RT, called the meeting to order at 11:45 a.m.

Motion to go into Executive Session 11:46 p.m. via roll call in accordance with Idaho Code § 67- 2345(b), (d) and (f) to consider the record for RESA-956 subsequent to Respondent's application for Respiratory Therapy licensure and to consider the Hearing record in contested Case No. 2009-RES-6441 and to make recommendations to the Board of Medicine. (White - Affirmed unanimously via roll call: White, Massey, Lincoln-Haye, Durham)

Applicant RESA-956 appeared telephonically for an interview.

The RT Board affirmed that each member had read the record in Case No. 2009-RES-6441 and that they each considered the matter solely on the contents of the record and made a recommendation to the Board of Medicine.

Motion to leave Executive Session 12:38 p.m. (Massey - Affirmed unanimously via roll call: White, Massey, Lincoln-Haye, Durham)

The RT Board acted to recommend granting licensure to Applicant RESA-956 upon execution of a time-limited Stipulation and Order. (White/Unanimous)

Case No. 2009-RES-6441 - After discussion and deliberation, the RT Board acted to recommend revocation of permit to practice as a polysomnography technologist. (Massey/Unanimous)

In further business, the RT Board acted to request that Board staff pursue legislation to change the Board member compensation to an honorarium. (Massey/Unanimous)

Chairman Rich White, RT adjourned the RT Board meeting at 12:55 p.m.
