RESPIRATORY THERAPY LICENSURE BOARD
MEETING

Boise, Idaho

Thursday, April 11, 2013

PARTICIPATING:

The meeting was called to order at 9:04 A.M. by Chairperson Richard White, RT, Hayden. Participating were; Carrie Bates, RT, Pingree, Marilyn Shuler public member Boise. Diana Lincoln-Haye, RPSGT, RT, Kimberly participated by conference call. Travis Williams, public member, Boise was absent and excused. Also attending were Mary Leonard, associate director, and Jodi Adcock, technical records specialist I.

MINUTES:

The minutes of the October 11, 2012 meeting and February 11, 2013 conference call were approved. Unless otherwise noted, all actions were taken on motions duly made and adopted unanimously. (Motion-White; Affirmed-Unanimous)

ADMINISTRATION:

The RTL Board was provided with their board's FY 2013 financial report.

The RTL Board reviewed Rule changes which were approved by the 2013 Legislature which includes minor housekeeping changes and will not allow polysomnography technicians that do not pass the BRPT within the allowed duration of their permit to re-apply as a trainee.

The RTL Board acted to set their next meeting date for Thursday October 10, 2013, at 9:00 A.M. (Motion - Bates/Affirmed-Unanimous)

The RTL Board reviewed and discussed the RTL Board's policy regarding home delivery and set up of respiratory equipment, supplies and medications including oxygen. The members restated their position as follows:

Respiratory equipment, supplies and medication including oxygen may be delivered to a patient at home. However, the initial set-

up and training of the use of the equipment, supplies and medication requires the skill and knowledge of a licensed respiratory care practitioner or other qualified licensed health care provider. Any changes to the settings of the equipment, dosage of the medication or liter flow of oxygen must be made by a licensed respiratory care practitioner or qualified licensed health care provider.

The respiratory equipment and supplies affected by this policy include but are not limited to the following:

- Positive pressure airway devices
- High frequency chest wall oscillation devices/supplies
- Invasive mechanical ventilation
- Intermittent positive pressure breathing IPPB devices
- Intrapulmonary percussive ventilation devices
- Mechanical in-exsufflation devices
- Nebulizer equipment, supplies and medications
- Oxygen equipment and/or supplies
- Respiratory assist devices
- Respiratory suction pumps
- Tracheostomy care supplies
- Ventilators, accessories and/or supplies

(Motion-Bates/Unanimous)

The RTL Board members also noted that third party payers including Medicare and Medicaid may have additional requirements to be met by the Durable Medical Equipment suppliers.

In accordance with Idaho Code, section 67-2345 (1) (b), (d) and (f), the RTL Board moved to go into Executive Session at 9:55 A.M. to consider the results of investigations and information presented in each discipline case. (Motion-Shuler; Affirmed-White, Bates, Lincoln-Haye)

The RTL Board acted to leave executive session and go into open session at 10:21 P.M. (Motion-White; Affirmed-Bates, Shuler, Lincoln-Haye)
